As we begin our 63rd year in the registered Black Angus business, we are proud to be considered one of the few true maternal cow herds remaining in America. Due to circumstances outlined below we are offering you an opportunity to acquire maternal genetics from the heart of our program.


Twenty months ago, our son Dixon, who was our ranch manager for 18 years, suffered a major leg injury which required nine months of rehabilitation. Shortly thereafter he resigned to pursue other opportunities outside of our family business. As a result of his departure and my age, we have decided it is time to reduce the size of our herd by 50%, which will reduce our stocking rates, our labor requirements and the administration time required to continue our seed stock operation. To date we have reduced our herd from 144 registered cows to 86. It has been painful to select the animals we are selling.

We are now selling another 20 head out of the heart of the herd by way of a Private Treaty Offering online. This sale book has been developed to operate as a living document. We retain the right to remove or add animals and adjust prices as we deem appropriate at our sole discretion.
